YALE'S WRESTLING HONORS.

Scores Comparatively Easy Victory in the Intercollegiate Meet.

PRINCETON, March 21.—Yale won the intercollegiate championship in the wrestling tournament here to-night comparatively easy. Princeton tied with Columbia for second place after a disappointing showing, with Pennsylvania fourth. Columbia's unexpectedly good showing upset the Tigers' expectations of success and was responsible for Yale's finally winning out. The New York team scored seven points where she was believed to have hardly a chance to tally, equalling Princeton's total. Yale with eleven had a safe margin.
