YALE WRESTLERS WIN.

Columbia Grapplers Fail to Win a Point in Intercollegiate Bouts.

PHILADELPHIA, March 20.—Yale, by scoring 9 points, secured first place here to-night in the fourth annual intercollegiate wrestling meet with the University of Pennsylvania, Princeton, Cornell, and Columbia Universities. Pennsylvania was second, with 6 points, and Princeton and Cornell were tied with three points, while Columbia failed to score a mark.

The notable features were the defeat of Folwell, the light heavyweight champion of Pennsylvania, by Foster of Yale, and the defeat of Goebel, the Yale heavyweight, by Talbot of Cornell. In the semi-finals Holzworth of Columbia forfeited to Foster, and this left Yale's representative fresh to wrestle with Folwell, who had previously had a hard battle with King of Princeton. With the exception of T. and L. Dole of Yale, none of the winners had previously been title holders.
