

Pennsy Beats Army at Hockey.

WEST POINT, Jan. 8.—In the first game of the local hockey season the University of Pennsylvania team defeated the cadets here to-day by 1 goal to 0. Early in the game the Quakers worked the puck repeatedly into the soldiers' territory, Dewitt and King handling the rubber skillfully, but the fine army defense turned aside many well-aimed shots. The first score came about the middle of the first period, Dewitt shooting from a scrimmage in front of the cage. In the final period Day and Sibert did some fine work, carrying the puck the length of the court, and but for the alertness of Ward the army must have scored.
