

Quaker and Tiger Wrestlers Tie.

PRINCETON, N. J., March 18.—Pennsylvania and Princeton tied here to-night at wrestling with $3\frac{1}{2}$ points each. In the gymnastic competition the Quakers won, 35 to 19. There were three draws in the wrestling—Prettyman of Princeton and McCutcheon; Capt. Stewart of Pennsylvania and H. A. Ormond, neither of whom has been thrown this year, and Nisson of Pennsylvania and Penfield, Princeton. Extra periods failed to bring throws. Glaspey of Pennsylvania secured a fall out of Elmendorf; Frantz of Princeton threw Miller; A. T. Ormond of Princeton threw Young, and Stielman of Pennsylvania threw McLean. Pennsylvania had twenty-three entries to Princeton's nine in the gymnastics and had no trouble winning.
