

Penn Freshmen Win.

PENNINGTON, N. J., Oct. 7.—Pennington Seminary football team journeyed to Philadelphia to-day and succeeded in holding the heavy Pennsylvania Freshman team to a 11 to 6 score. The Philadelphia team succeeded in scoring two touchdowns and kicking one goal during the first few minutes of play. Pennsylvania twice returned kicks, and the ball went out of bounds close to the Pennington team's goal line. When the pigskin was brought in their heavy line succeeded in aiding the back field in taking the ball over for the scores. Pennington's score was the result of a seventy-five-yard run by Capt. Duffy in the last period of the game after receiving the ball on his twenty-five-yard line. By good interference he ran the length of the field for the score and then kicked the goal.
