

Cornell Wrestlers Throw Penn.

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 20.—The Cornell wrestling team, holders of the intercollegiate title, defeated the University of Pennsylvania wrestlers here to-night, four bouts to two. One match ended in a draw. Dorizas, the Greek athlete, who represented Pennsylvania in the heavyweight class, threw Kleinert of Cornell in 24 seconds. Capt. Boak of Cornell, the intercollegiate champion in the 125-pound class, threw Wooley of Pennsylvania, in 3 minutes and 50 seconds, with a half-Nelson.
