

CORNELL WRESTLERS WIN.

Win Three Bouts and Score 24 Points in Intercollegiates.

SOUTH BETHLEHEM, Pa., March 27.—For the third consecutive year Cornell captured the intercollegiate wrestling championship by scoring 24 points in the eleventh annual meet held here today in the gymnasium of Lehigh University. Lehigh secured second place with 19 points, Pennsylvania third with 13, Princeton fourth with 11, and Columbia fifth with 4 points.

The finals and bouts for second and third places were held today, and these champions were produced: Culbertson, Cornell, 115-pound class; Martin, Lehigh, 125-pound class; Post, Cornell, 135-pound class; Thomas, Lehigh, 145-pound class; Galloghy, Cornell, 158-pound class; Pendleton, Columbia, 175-pound class; Dorizas, Pennsylvania, heavyweight class. Dorizas and Culbertson each scored seven points.

Cornell secured three firsts, two seconds, and one third; Lehigh two firsts and three seconds; Pennsylvania one first, one second, and two thirds; Princeton two seconds and two thirds; Columbia one first place.

Today's victory for Cornell depended upon the 115-pound class, when Culbertson threw Kirkuff of Lehigh. In an early-season meet Kirkuff threw Culbertson and was picked to win today, but the Cornell man got a half-Nelson hold on him in five minutes.

Officers elected by the association today for next year were A. W. Littleton, President; H. Jones, Columbia, Vice President; S. Thraner, Princeton, Secretary and Treasurer. The finals:

125 Pounds.—Martin, Lehigh, won on decision from Woolley, University of Pennsylvania.

135 Pounds.—Post, Cornell, won on decision from Tancock, Princeton.

145 Pounds.—Thomas, Lehigh, won on decision from Frantz, Princeton. Time—15:00.

158 Pounds.—Galloghy, Cornell, threw Statler, Pennsylvania.

175 Pounds.—Pendleton, Columbia, won from McKeage, Cornell, on decision.

Heavyweight.—Dorizas, Pennsylvania, threw Kleinert, Cornell. Time—1:07.
