

QUAKERS TOY WITH TIGERS

Penn Five Easily Defeats Princeton at Basket Ball.

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 12.—The University of Pennsylvania basket ball quintet outclassed Princeton in an intercollegiate game in Weightman Hall tonight, winning by the score of 28 to 17.

Princeton was the first to score on a double foul, Flynn dropping the ball in the basket twice in quick succession. In less than three minutes, however, the Red and Blue had surpassed the Orange and Black by scoring a field and foul goal and from that stage of the game the Quakers never were headed.
