

# SYRACUSE FIVE BEATS PENN

## Up-State Team Continues Supreme Over Quakers.

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 25.—Syracuse defeated Penn at basketball for the eighth consecutive time by the score of 27 to 24 tonight. Penn was much lighter than the New York up-staters but this added to their speed and made the contest a battle from bell to bell. Thirteen fouls were called on each.

Dolley for Syracuse was the star field goal shooter, placing five in the cage for his team. With Penn leading close to the end of the first half, Dolley shot two field goals in succession and gave his team the lead at half time, 15—13.
