PHILADELPHIA, May 31. - Penn routed Yale at Franklin Field today, 8 to 3. The Red and Blue batters knocked Kelly out of the box in one and one-third innings and then proceeded to hammer Coxe, his successor, to all corners of

Penn started the scoring in the first inning. McNichol singled, and moved to second on Shriver's sacrifice. Aldrich booted Sweeney's roller and McNichol scored. Straus walked and Yates sin-gled. Sweeney was caught between the bases, but Straus scored on a wild pitch.

Three Red and Blue tailies were scored in the second. With one down, Myers walked, Huntzinger doubled, and so did McNichol, scoring Myers and Huntzinger. This was enough for Pitcher Kelly of Yale, and Coxe took his place. Mc-Nichol moved to third on Coxe's error. Shriver walked and stole. On a pretty squeeze play, McNichol scored. Shriver also attempted to get in but was tagged out at home.

The home-run smashes of Myers and Warwick produced the final Penn runs, in the fourth and fifth innings.

Until the eighth inning Yale was shut

out. Then Aldrich singled and moved to second on Peters's out on Coxe's grounder. Shriver, Penn's short stop, made his third poor throw of the game and the ball rolled past Yates, Aldrich scoring and Coxe taking second. Crane was out, but Sawyer singled, scoring Coxe.
