

ST. NICKS OUTPLAY PENN.

New York Hockey Team Registers 7-1 Victory Over Collegians.

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 8.—The St. Nicholas hockey team of New York defeated the University of Pennsylvania by 7 to 1 at the Ice Palace tonight. Tonight's game was Penn's first big contest of the season.
