

PENN WRESTLERS BEATEN.

Red and Blue Grapplers Succumb to
Lehigh—Score, 19 to 8.

BETHLEHEM, Pa., March 12.—Minus the services of Captain Johnny Bertolet and Eddie Loesser, the two Lehigh veterans already selected for the intercollegiates, Lehigh University grapplers rode roughshod over the University of Pennsylvania mat men here today, winning 19 to 8.

The decision won by Ashby, and a fall by Ward, of Penn, over Carlisle, in the unlimited class, were the only points garnered by the Red and Blue.

115-Pound Class—Schwartzbach, Lehigh, won from Chassias, Penn., by default after two extra three-minute periods.

125-Pound Class—Meyers, Lehigh, threw Hadelor, Penn., with a body hold and half Nelson. Time—4:38.

135-Pound Class—Gihon, Lehigh, threw Grant, Penn., with a hammerlock and grapevine hold in two extra three-minute periods. Time—9:24.

145-Pound Class—Shoemaker, Lehigh, won by decision over Holland, Penn., in two extra three-minute periods.

158-Pound Class—Ashby, Penn., won by decision over Coxe, Lehigh.

175-Pound Class—Good, Lehigh, won by decision over Pendleton, Penn., in two extra three-minute periods.

Heavyweight Class—Ward, Penn., threw Carlisle, Lehigh, with a body hold. Time—3:10.
