

PENN NINE WINS BY 3 TO 2.

Hitting of Maradin Accounts for Victory Over Catholic University.

WASHINGTON, March 29.—Timely hitting by Maradin enabled the University of Pennsylvania nine to down Catholic University today, 3 to 2. He drove home all of the Quakers' tallies in a game that was a pitchers' battle between Stout of the visitors and Dallard of the locals.

In the fourth inning Whitehill hit with one gone, advanced on Myers's out and scored on Maradin's single. Maradin stole, but could get no help. Maradin again singled with two out in the seventh, when the locals were leading, 2 to 1, and sent home the winning markers. McNichol walked to start the inning, and Shriver was safe on Driscoll's error. Whitehill fanned, but the runners advanced on Myers's out, and Maradin was equal to the pinch.

Hits by O'Brien and Driscoll and a pass to Denault, followed by a double play, sent the last named across with the home team's first run. A pass to Vall, hits by McCuster and O'Brien, with an error mixed in, gave Catholic University one run in the second.
