BETHLEHEM, Pa., March 25 .- The

beam of grapplers representing Cornell

University staged a Garrison finish by capturing the final bouts of the 175 and Enlimited classes, and thereby won the eighteenth annual intercollegiate wrestling championship in the Taylor Gymnasium at Lehigh University this afternoon. Cornell forged to the front when Hansen won the decision and title by defeating Wilson of State in the 175pound class, and counted additional

points immediately afterward when Wright blasted Yale's hopes in the unlimited weight division by defeating Mackay in a close tussle. In the final bouts Captain Watson of Penn State enjoyed the distinction of scoring the only fall of the meet. Waton threw Schwarzbach of Lehigh with

a crotch hold and a half nelson in 5

minutes and 24 seconds. Cornell's winners were Roberts in the 125-pound class, Hansen and Wright. State with Parks captured the 145-pound title and Watson took the 115-pound laurels. The other champions are Wallace, Yale, 135-pound class, and Johnson, Columbia, 158-pound class. Cornell Leads by Seven Points. The team points are distributed as follows: Cornell 19, State 12, Yale 11, Lehigh 9. Columbia 8, Pennsylvania 3 and Princeton 2.

The runners-up in the finals to the in-

dividual champions are Ackerly, Cornell, 115-pound class; Weinschenk, State, 125 pounds; Gihon, Lehigh, 135 pounds; Shoemaker, Lehigh, 145 pounds; Benjamin, Yale, 158 pounds; Parsonette, Columbia, 175 pounds, and Mackay, Yale, unlimited unlimited. The third place men are Schwab, Columbia, 115-pound class; Chassens, Penn, 125 pounds; Davis, Penn, 135 pounds; Ayau. Cornell. 145 pounds; Coxe. Lehigh. 150 pounds; Wilson, State, 175 pounds, and Moorehouse, Lehigh, unlimited. Juggling 145-Pound Title.

The juggling of the 145-pound title was one of the features of the meet.
