

CORNELL SUCCUMBS TO PENN NINE, 10-9

Huntzinger Pitches His Ninth
Straight Victory of Season—
Has Poor Support in Field.

PHILADELPHIA, May 30.—The Cornell baseball team succumbed to Pennsylvania here this afternoon by 10 to 9. It was Huntzinger's ninth consecutive victory this season. Huntzinger held the Ithacans to eight hits and fanned nine men, but his support was very poor.

With three runs home in the ninth, only one needed to tie and two men out, Eddie Kaw, the Cornell football hero who wrought so much havoc on Franklin Field last Thanksgiving Day, ended the game on a force play. Three times before Kaw had struck out.
