

PENN GRAPPLERS TRIUMPH.

Win Six Out of Seven Events From
Virginia—Score Is 22-3.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa., Feb. 10.—Winning six out of seven events, the Penn wrestling team today defeated the grapplers from the University of Virginia at Weightman Hall by the score of 22 to 3. Two of the Red and Blue victories were through falls, the others by time advantages. Three of the bouts went into extra periods.

F. L. Kiep, Penn., won from J. Spry, Virginia, by fall in 3 minutes, 47 seconds.

R. Cubberly, Penn., won from B. Manning, Virginia, by fall in 1 minute, 1 second (two extra periods).

F. Herdeg, Penn., won from L. Hanger, Virginia. Time advantage—3 minutes, 43 seconds.

G. Maxham, Penn., won from L. Geaves, Virginia. Time advantage—3 minutes, 18 seconds.

C. Wight, Penn., won from S. Mullins, Virginia. Time advantage—1 minute, 56 seconds.

E. Holland, Virginia, won from P. Lutz, Penn. Time advantage—1 minute, 1 second. (Two extra periods.)

J. Taufman, Penn., won from J. Weaver, Virginia. Time advantage—54 seconds. (Two extra periods.)
