

15,000 SEE PENN BEAT YALE IN 11TH

**Schuff's Double Scores Miller
With Winning Run in "Straw
Hat" Day Game.**

QUAKERS GET THREE HITS

**Bunch Few Safeties With Ell Mis-
plays and Triumph, 4-3—
Homer for O'Hearn.**

PHILADELPHIA, May 5.—Before 15,000 persons, the largest crowd that ever has seen a straw hat day game at Franklin Field, Penn today defeated Yale, 4 to 3, in the eleventh inning.

Henry Schuff's double, with Miller and Westgate on the bases, driver in Miller with the Quaker's winning run. Schuff's drive went to left field and Neale did not chase it after it whizzed past him. Schuff made the complete circuit of the bases, and at first it was thought it was a home run, but Umpire Baetzel decided that the ball had not left the playing field and Schuff was not entitled to a home run.

Pond pitched remarkable ball for the Elis, holding Penn to two hits in 2 2-3 innings. For seven consecutive innings Penn did not get a hit off him. Penn made only three hits off Pond and Ross.

Walter Huntzinger was found for nine hits, but pitched well in the face of poor support by Shortstop Farrell, who made all four of Penn's errors. Huntzinger struck out nine men.

Penn scored two runs in the opening inning. Miller walked, Westgate was hit by a pitched ball, Pond made a wild throw to second and Farrell singled. Yale tied it up in the second on Kelley's single. Farrell's error of Hawks's grounder, Ewing's sacrifice, Goldblatt's passed ball and Pond's single.

In the Penn half of the second, McMullen scored on his triple to right centre and a wild pitch. Charlie O'Hearn tied it up with a home run. In the seventh, after that, it was a pitching battle until Schuff's double broke it up in the eleventh.
