

PENN CELEBRATES WITH 5-2 VICTORY

Defeats Dartmouth Nine as
Crowd of 20,000 Assembles
for Alumni Day.

LONG YIELDS THREE HITS

Youthful Pitcher Checks Opposing
Batsmen, but Proves Wild—Com-

PHILADELPHIA, June 14.—Alumni Day was celebrated by the University of Pennsylvania ball team today by defeating Dartmouth in a hard-fought game. A crowd of 20,000 saw the Red and Blue win after a struggle, with the final score 5 to 2.

Long, the youthful star of the Quaker pitching staff, was in fine form, holding the Dartmouth team to three scattered hits. Long was a tifle wild at times, but he pitched himself out of a number of bad holes.

Comerford, who was hurling for Dartmouth, allowed seven hits during the nine innings. After a bad session in the first and third he settled down and held Penn safe.
