## SYRACUSE WRESTLERS DEFEAT PENN, 23 TO 10

Only One Match, Patterson vs. Rev. Urban, Is Without Fall, Former Having Time Margin.

SYRACUSE, N. Y., Jan. 21.—Syracuse defeated the University of Pennsylvania, 23-10, in an intercollegiate wrestling meet at Archbold Gymnasium this afternoon.

The matches were spirited, six resulting in falls. The seventh and closing event in the unlimited division featured Jake Patterson, Orange football star, and the Rev. Charles Urban of Pennsylvania as opponents. The match went into extra periods and Patterson won ' -- a considerable time advantage.

Patterson was unable to throw his heavier adversary while the minister athlete was unable to cope with the experience of the Orange star, who is the intercollegiate champion. Captain Charles Okun of Syracuse, 115-pound intercollegiate champion, threw Crisman of Pennsylvania. Okun lost his opening match last week.
