## 11 ICE HOCKEY GAMES

**Revives Sport and Books 11 Rivals—Starts Season Dec. 11 at Home With St. Nicholas A. C.**

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 3.—Pennsylvania's hockey team will play a schedule of eleven games this season, Ernest B. Cozens, graduate manager, announced today. Eight of them will be held at the Arena. Princeton, Yale and Harvard appear on the home list. The season opens Dec. 11 with St. Nicholas A. C. of New York, a team composed largely of City College players.

This year's schedule marks the revival of ice hockey at Pennsylvania. The sport was dropped for some years on account of lack of funds. This year's team is captained by Francis Boggs of Hingham, Mass.

The Pennsylvania gymnastic team schedule also was announced and includes the intercollegiate championships here late in March.
