

# PENN RALLY BEATS COLUMBIA ON MAT

Trailing, 12 to 0, Captures Last  
Four Matches to Gain Vic-  
tory by 15-12 Score.

## FINAL CONTEST DECIDES

Gabriel, Red and Blue Leader, Gains  
Overtime Decision Over Baker—  
Frei Throws Scott.

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 19. — By taking the last four matches, Pennsylvania today staged a sensational rally to beat Columbia in the opening wrestling meet of the season here, 15 to 12.

With the score deadlocked at 12-all, Captain Phil Gabriel of the Red and Blue gained an overtime decision over Baker of the Lions in the heavyweight class to give Penn the victory. Baker did his best work in the regulation and first extra period, but weakened after that.

Henry Scott, Columbia's football player, was thrown by Gil Frei of Brooklyn in the second extra period, the Penn wrestler pinning Scott with a body scissors and arm lock.

In the opening match Maurice Gamm of New Haven, Penn's 115 pounder, suffered a dislocated left elbow and had to forfeit to Nichols during the second extra period. The other Columbia winners were Captain Simmons in the 135-pound division and Farmllett, star 125 pounder.

At the end of the third bout the Lions held a 12-to-0 lead, then Penn staged its rally.

115-Pound Class—Nichols, Columbia, won from Gamm, Penn., by default, in second extra period.

125-Pound Class—Farmllett, Columbia, defeated Roepke, Penn. Time advantage—6:50.

135-Pound Class—Simmons, Columbia, defeated Reynolds, Penn., two extra periods. Time advantage—2:37.

145-Pound Class—Pappano, Penn., defeated Relyea, Columbia, two extra periods. Time advantage—36 seconds.

158-Pound Class—Knepper, Penn., defeated Parry, Columbia. Time advantage—9:28.

175-Pound Class—Frei, Penn., threw Scott, Columbia, with scissors and arm lock in second extra period. Time—2:26.

Heavyweight Class—Gabriel, Penn., defeated Baker, Columbia, two extra periods.
