

PENN WRESTLERS WIN.

Beat Duke, 18-15, as Knepper's
Victory Breaks 15-15 Tie.

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 23.—Dick Knepper of Pennsylvania won his 165-pound match with Williams today and enabled his team to beat Duke University, 18 to 15. This bout went two extra periods. The score was tied at 15-15 when Knepper took up his bout.

In the heavyweight class Captain Phil Gabriel of Penn threw Davis of Duke with a crotch and chancery hold.
