BOW TO PENN, 28-8

Yield in Six Matches Out of Eight —Captain Lifrak Loses to Pappano.

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., March 2.—

The University of Pennsylvania wrestling team, scoring victories in six of eight divisions, won from Harvard here today, 28 to 8.

Warner of Harvard, in the unlimited class, and Levine of Harvard, in the 135-pound class, won interesting matches from their Pennsylvania opponents. Pappano of Pennsylvania defeated Captain Lifrak, Harvard's star in the 145-pound class, in the closest match of the afternoon. Another hard-fought battle between Frei of Pennsylvania and Kaufman of Harvard in the 165-pound class was won by the visiting contestant.
