

# PENN NINE DEFEATS WAKE FOREST BY 8-7

## Victors Take Lead in Second, Scoring Five Runs After Losers Get One in First.

WAKE FOREST, N. C., March 28.—By scoring in the early innings the University of Pennsylvania baseball team won an 8-7 victory over Wake Forest College here this afternoon. Penn went ahead on five runs in the second after the home team tallied one run in the first.

In the final analysis a hidden ball play saved the day for the victors and stopped a rally. During Wake Forest's ninth, when the Deacons scored two runs, Al Walker, Penn third baseman, hid the ball after Hord had made a triple to drive in a run and then tagged Hord out at third.
