

AMHERST SUBDUES PENN SEXTET, 3-2

Triumphs in Fast Contest in
Philadelphia Arena—Leads,
2-0, in First Period.

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 10.—The Amherst College ice hockey team defeated the University of Pennsylvania six tonight in a fast game, 3 to 2, at the arena.

Turner of Amherst scored the first goal 3 minutes and 13 seconds after the start, and at the end of the first period Amherst was ahead, 2 to 0, on Nichols's goal three minutes before the intermission.

Penn held the visitors scoreless in the second period, while Charley Greene of Forest Hills, L. I., tallied for the Red and Blue in 9 minutes and 48 seconds.

In the final period each team scored again, Turner for the New Englanders in 14:07, while Pringle scored on a pass from O'Reilly in 28 seconds before the end of the match.
