PHILADELPHIA, April 14.—Hans Lobert's Bridgeport (Conn.) baseball team of the Eastern League visited Franklin Field today and defeated the University of Pennsylvania nine, 8 to 6.

Save for one bad inning, the fourth, when Mervin Drewes, Red and Blue left-hander, was on the mound, Penn made a creditable showing. Drewes; who had relieved Jim Peterson, was greeted by a triple by Walter Kimmick. The next two batters singled, doubled and tripled in the order named and five runs were across the plate.
