

PENN WRESTLERS SCORE.

Defeat Princeton, 19-11, as Mann
Returns to Action.

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 11.—With Captain Kenneth Mann making his first appearance of the season, Penn defeated Princeton, 19 to 11, in a wrestling meet at the Palestra today.

Mann had been out with influenza. He managed to gain a decision over Charles Classen of the Tigers in the 175-pound class. Mann is the 1932 intercollegiate 165-pound champion.

The Red and Blue got away to a 10-0 lead in the first two bouts when Arthur Moll and Ellis Finkelman scored falls over James Avati and Garrett Richter, in the 115 and 125-pound classes.
