

VILLANOVA WINS IN 10TH.

Defeats Penn Nine, 8-7, on Two-Bagger by Montgomery.

PHILADELPHIA, May 23.—Villanova used up three Pennsylvania pitchers to win from the Red and Blue on Franklin Field today, 8 to 7, in ten innings. Pitcher Jack Montgomery drove across what turned out to be the winning run with a two-bagger.

Henry Kazloff, first man up for Penn in the tenth, hit a home run. This is the second straight year Villanova has beaten Penn in extra innings.
