

PENN SOCCER TEAM BLANKS CORNELL, 6-0

Wins Sixth Straight Game and Annexes Middle Atlantic States League Title.

PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 30.—Scoring its sixth consecutive victory of the season, the University of Pennsylvania team won the Middle Atlantic States Intercollegiate Soccer League championship today by defeating Cornell, 6 to 0, at River Field.

Penn took a 2-0 lead in the first half and added four more goals in the second to blank the visitors.

Lin Hsu, Chinese who plays inside left, converted a pass from Scott McKinley for the first Red and Blue goal five minutes after the opening whistle.
