PHILADELPHIA, March 24.—The University of Pennsylvania varsity lacrosse team opened the season by beating the Philadelphia Lacrosse Club on snow-covered River Field today, 3 to 2.

Frank Mayetta scored in the third period, but the clubmen got started on goals by Wands, former Penn captain, and Randy Rosenbaum, substitute for Edell. With three minutes left to play, George Strang put across the winning goal.
