

PENN BEATS P. M. C. AT BASKETBALL, 32-18

*Hanger, With 13 Points, Stars
for Victors, Who Lead by
14-7 at Half.*

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 18.—Acting Captain Roger Hanger starred in the Pennsylvania five's victory over P. M. C. at the Palestra tonight, 32 to 18.

The lanky center contributed 13 points on six field goals and one foul toss. The cadets held the Red and Blue, 8 to 7, in the first ten minutes but wilted after that and trailed at the half, 14-7.

Jim Seward and Danny McFadden each made 5 points for the cadets. In the preliminary game the Penn junior varsity won its first game of the season, beating the Penn A. C. jayvees, 28-25.
