

NAVY TURNS BACK GEORGETOWN, 4-3

Victors Get All Their Runs in First Inning on Four Hits and Three Passes

ANNAPOLIS, Md., May 21.—Scoring all of its runs in the first inning today, the Navy took one of the few baseball games it has won from Georgetown in the 50-year-old series. The score was 4 to 3.

Mike Petroskey, who has a long record of victories, started off badly. Three passes and four hits, including Ingram's triple, and an error, accounted for the Navy's total.

Placing first in ten of the fourteen events, with one tie, the Navy track team won from the University of Virginia, 84½ to 41½.

The track record in the 220-yard dash was broken by three-tenths of a second when Jack Dalton went the distance in 0:21.3. Dalton also won the 100, in 0:09.9. Irwin Fike of the Navy, taking the discus and javelin contests, was the only other double winner. Fike also finished third in the shot-put for a total of 11 points.

In the 880-yard event the lead saw-sawed between Cutts of Navy and Goodall of Virginia, and the Navy man triumphed by five yards in the final sprint.

The Navy lacrosse team kept its record against collegiate opponents clean by winning from the University of Pennsylvania, 14 to 0.

Ruhe and Moore lead the Navy attack in the first period, while Hedrick, entering the game in the second quarter, scored two goals in that session and two more in the early part of the third.
