

YALE, PENN IN MAT TIE

Pickett Defeats Wolf in Final Match to Make Count, 14-14.

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 13—Larry Pickett's victory over Bob Wolf in the heavyweight division enabled Yale to gain a 14-14 tie with Penn's wrestling team at the Palestra today.

Pickett, 205, conceded at least fifty-five pounds to the Red and Blue veteran, but claimed the referee's decision. Each team gained one fall and three decisions.

One of the surprises was in the 145-pound class, when Warren Tischler, star of last year's Penn freshman team, defeated Captain David Gerber, Eastern intercollegiate runner-up.
