Smith limited the visitors to four widely scattered blows and was in trouble only in the sixth inning when Burns and Broberg singled. Dartmouth lost its chance to score as the Tar infield completed a fast double play to end the inning. Smith fanned twelve men, including the last two batters to face him.

In Trouble at Start

Will Gray started for Dartmouth but got into trouble in the first inning when Sherwood Werner hit a home run far over Right Field Dix Daniel's head. Jackie Stowe, who had reached first on an error, and Jack Brennan, who hit safely, were on the bases at the time of the circuit clout

Another Dartmouth miscue and a two-bagger by Stowe produced a fourth Navy tally in the second inning. Smith helped his own cause with a single which scored two unearned markers in the third. Big Pidge Hughes took over the mound duty for the Big Green team in the sixth and Navy got to him for their final trio of runs in the seventh.
