

# PENN TRIPS SWARTHMORE

Scores Twice in Ninth to Win  
Behind Johnson, 4 to 2

PHILADELPHIA, July 15—  
Clint Johnson, Penn hurler, walked  
nine men and hit four batters, but  
he buckled down in the pinches  
and yielded only two hits to give  
the Quakers a 4-2 decision over  
Swarthmore today.

Johnson twirled hitless ball un-  
til the eighth when Bill Monshein  
bunted safely and Pitcher Bob  
Lobell lined a single to right. Penn  
won by scoring two runs in the  
ninth.
