

PRINCETON TEAMS EXCEL

Tigers Beat Penn in Swimming and Wrestling Events

PRINCETON, N. J., Feb. 4—Varsity swimming and wrestling victories over invading Pennsylvania aggregations highlighted the "clean sweep" registered today by six of Princeton's sports teams in the Dillon Gym.

Capturing nine first places, the Tiger varsity mermen outstroked the Quakers, 53—22, for their second straight Eastern League victory. The Princeton Freshmen trounced the Penn yearlings, 62—13.

Falls credited to Nassau's Dave Poor and Bob Sellers marked Princeton's 19-11 varsity mat triumph. The Red and Blue freshmen and junior varsity wrestlers were downed by 23—8 and 18—6 scores, respectively.

The Navy varsity racqueteers were shut out, 9—0, as the Orange and Black squash team extended its victory skein to four straight.
