

Quakers Finish Third

PHILADELPHIA, March 10 (AP) —The University of Pennsylvania broke open a tight game midway in the second half to defeat Princeton, 74—63, tonight at the Palestra.

A crowd of 5,396 saw both Eastern Intercollegiate League fives end their respective seasons.

Penn (19—8) broke a 50—50 tie with eleven minutes remaining to pour it on in the final stages of the contest, posting its seventh league victory in twelve games.

Princeton (15—7) with a 5—7 league record, finished in fourth place behind the Quakers.

Penn's sophomore center, Ernie Beck, tallied 24 points to raise his final league-leading total to 244.

Villanova halted Siena, 78—57, in the second game of the double-header.
