

**Quakers Win at Hanover**

HANOVER, N. H., Jan. 12—The University of Pennsylvania's basketball team outplayed a game Dartmouth squad to win, 73—67, tonight. The Quakers were led by sophomore Dick Heylmun, who scored 20 points, and Ernie Beck, who played only the second half and dropped in fourteen markers.

The Quakers were especially strong under the offensive and defensive board. Don Scanlon, the Penn captain, stood out at taking rebounds off the boards until late in the third quarter, when he fouled out and was replaced by Alex Jaffers who kept up the good work.

For Dartmouth, sophomore center Paul Widom was the whole show on a sophomore-loaded team. He scored 20 points and picked almost every Dartmouth rebound off the boards. He was followed in the scoring department by another sophomore, Art Patterson, who entered the game in the second half and scored 13 points on his set shots.

For the Quakers it was their second Ivy League victory in as many starts, while it was the second loss in as many games for the Indians.
