ITHACA, N. Y., Jan. 19—Princeton was knocked from the ranks of the unbeaten in Eastern Intercollegiate Basketball League competition tonight by bowing to Cornell, 67 to 51.

The Big Red kept its league slate clean with a masterful defensive performance that kept the Tigers well out from the hoops. Cornell's attack, particularly from the foul line, was slightly less than sensational. Coach Roy Green's men scored 21 of 24 free throws, while the best Princeton could do was to convert 11 of 19.

Big John Werner, senior from St. Albans, continued his scoring streak with 25 points to pace both teams in this respect. He caged ten baskets and dropped all five chances from the foul line.

Pace Slow at Start

The game started slowly and was 3 to 2 in Cornell's favor after five minutes. At this stage the pace quickened and baskets by Cooper and Dave Sisler gave Princeton a 10-to-7 lead at the eight-minute mark. It was the only time the Tigers were ahead. Cornell had a 14-10 first-quarter lead, was ahead at half-time, 32 to 24, and out front, 47 to 36, after the third quarter.

Captain Charles Devoe was high gun for Princeton with 11 points. The triumph gave Cornell a 3-0 standing in the league and Princeton a 2-1 record. The victory was Cornell's tenth in fourteen games, while the Princeton mark sank to 5-8.
