

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 16 (UP)—A 12-point outburst in the third period enabled the University of Pennsylvania's basketball team to defeat Navy, 70—65, tonight in the second half of a Palestra twin bill.

In the opener, Villanova College rallied in the final minutes to score an upset, 86-84 triumph over the University of Louisville.

Sophomore Dick Heylmun, with 8 straight points, led the Quaker rally which saw them erase a 49-40 deficit to go on to their fifteenth triumph in twenty-one games. Navy now stands 13—7 for the season.

Heylmun, the Penn point leader with 22 points, popped in a series of long one-hand shots. Then when reserve Dick Harter sank 7 consecutive points at the close of the period, the Quakers took a 56-51 lead which was never seriously threatened.

Navy's John Clune matched Heylmun's 22-point output. Ernie Beck, Penn's Ivy League scoring leader, notched 17, while Harter had 11 and Tom Holt 10. Don Lange and Ken McCally scored 14 each for Navy.
