

Penn Takes 5th in Row

CHESTER, Pa., Dec. 17—Ernie Beck and Dick Heylmun led the University of Pennsylvania to its fifth straight victory tonight as it defeated Swarthmore College, 79—54, on the Swarthmore court. The home team's Joe Carroll carried off the scoring honors with 31 points. Beck had 28 and Heylmun had 20. Penn led, 32—22, at the half with Dick Heylmun doing most of the scoring.
