

# PENN FIVE SUBDUES SYRACUSE BY 71-67

## 24-Point Effort by Heylmun Helps Quakers Score 15th Victory—Beck Checked

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 19 (AP)—Syracuse held Penn's high-scoring center, Ernie Beck, to 11 points, but his team-mate, Dick Heylmun, came through with a brilliant second-half shooting display to give Penn its fifteenth victory in eighteen starts, 71—67, at the Palestra tonight.

Heylmun's 24-point performance enabled the Quakers to stave off Syracuse's late rally that chopped a 13-point deficit to 3 points. Although the score was tied five times, Penn did not gain the lead until midway in the second quarter.
