

PENN TURNS BACK HARVARD, 87 TO 46

Registers Ninth Ivy League Victory as Heylmun Sets Pace With 26 Points

PHILADELPHIA, March 3—Pennsylvania's defending Eastern Intercollegiate League basketball champions remained in the running for this year's title by drubbing Harvard, 87—46, in the first game of a Palestra double-header tonight. It was Penn's highest score of the season.

Villanova defeated Iona, 65—53, in the second game.

Penn's victory was its ninth in the league against three losses. Cornell leads with a 10-2 record. Princeton is tied with Penn for second place.

Captain Dick Heylmun scored 26 points for Penn to become the third red and blue player to reach the 1,000-point mark. Ernie Beck and Herb Lyon were previous Penn men to reach that figure.

Penn's overall mark now is 16—7, while Harvard is 9—13, with nine defeats in a row.
