

Cornell Wins With 16 Hits

ITHACA, N. Y., May 15—Cornell collected sixteen hits off Walt Hynoski and Chet Cornog to defeat Pennsylvania, 9—4, in an Eastern Intercollegiate Baseball League game today.

Cornell scored five runs in the first inning for a 5-2 lead. Bill DeGraaf scattered nine Quaker hits. Mike Dalton, with three safeties, including a double, led the visitors' attack. Capt. Don Jacobs had three hits for Cornell.

It was the Ithacans' third victory in six league contests and Pennsylvania's fourth loss in seven games, one of which ended in a tie.
