

# Schuck's Grand Slam for Penn Overcomes Columbia by 7 to 5

## Seventh-Inning Quaker Home Run Nips Lions in League Game at Baker Field

A grand slam homer by Steve Schuck in the seventh inning enabled Penn to beat Columbia, 7-5, at Baker Field yesterday. Schuck, a replacement in the Quaker line-up after he appeared as a pinch hitter in the fifth, cleared the bases with his blow over the right-field fence.

Until then, Columbia held a 5-3 lead in the Eastern Intercollegiate League game. The Lions got three runs in the fourth. Their pitcher, Warren Smith, tripled to score Bob D'Augelli. Frank Pepe then clouted a homer over the center-field barrier.
