

Penn Beats Cornell

ITHACA, N. Y., May 24—An unearned run in the top of the eleventh enabled Penn to gain a 4-3 verdict over Cornell in baseball today. Penn moved into a second place tie in the Eastern League with Dartmouth, both schools having 6-2 season marks. For Cornell, it was the third loss in seven games.

George Gary, the Penn catcher, blasted a solo homer and hit a bases-filled single, good for two runs. In the eleventh, Gary blasted a ball to shortstop, where Bob Flynn let it go through him. Chuck Kahn scored from second on the error.
