Villanova Ace's 17 Points
Help Top Penn—Duquesne
Five Bows, 61 to 58

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 23 (AP) — The Villanova five scored 21 points in six minutes of the second period tonight and went on to trounce Penn, 71-58 in the second game of a Palestra double-header. Len Wilkins' clutch scoring helped Providence upset St. Joseph's in the opener, 64-63.

Villanova, trailing, 29-24, at the half, hit on seven of its first ten shots after the intermission. Paced by George Raveling, John Driscoll and Dick Kaminski, it swept into the lead.

The Wildcats' increased the margin to 18 points before easing up. Raveling was high for Villanova with 17 points, a total matched by the Quakers' Dave Kwait. Villanova is 12-1 for the season and Penn 7-8.
