

## Mlkvy Scores 30 Points

ITHACA, N. Y., Feb. 13—Cornell withstood a fine individual performance by Pennsylvania's Bob Mlkvy tonight to down the Quakers, 66—63, in basketball. Pacing the Big Red attack was George Farley and Jay Harris with 21 and 19 points, respectively.

The second half began with Cornell holding a 32—29 lead. Midway through the half the Big Red scored 8 straight points to go ahead, 56—50.

Penn threatened when, with eight seconds to go, Mlkvy made a 3-point play to close gap to 65—63.

A free shot by Farley with a second remaining produced the Big Red's final marker.

Mlkvy scored 30 points.
