HANOVER, N. H., Feb. 26 (AP)—Dartmouth broke a two-game losing streak in Ivy League play tonight with a 67-61 basketball victory over Penn. The Big Green had lost six days ago to the same team at Philadelphia.

The victory, coupled with Princeton's 76-67 triumph over Harvard, kept Dartmouth and Princeton deadlocked for the league lead with 8-3 records. The leaders meet at Hanover tomorrow night.

Walt Sosnowski and Chuck Kaufman, guards, paced the victors. Sosnowski tied Penn's Joe Cook for scoring honors at 18 points. Kaufman, held to 5 points, continually set up Sosnowski for drives and Gary Vandeweghe for lay-ups.

Penn tied at 54—54 with five minutes to play on a jump shot from the side by John Gamba. Cook then put the visitors ahead with a free throw.

Dartmouth took the lead for good with three minutes to go when Sosnowski stole the ball and drove all the way for a 2-pointer.
