

Penn Beats Cornell, 58-47

PHILADELPHIA, March 4 (AP)—Cornell was eliminated from the race for first place in the Ivy League when the Big Red basketball team bowed to Penn, 58-47, tonight.

In the second game of the doubleheader at the Palestra, Temple defeated Penn State, 79 to 68.

Bob Mlkvy, with 16 points, and Stew Greenleaf, with fourteen rebounds, nine in the second half, led Penn to victory. The Quakers, who led almost all the way, faltered midway in the second period when Cornell drew up to 39—35 and 45—41.

With seven minutes left Penn reeled off 6 straight points to put its lead out of danger. The half-time score was 30—22.

George Farley was high man with 18 points.
